A four part series of information sharing and networking roundtable sessions were hosted by the Environmental Sustainability Resource Center (ESRC) for State E3 Project Leads in U.S. EPA Regions 3 and 4. Sessions were held bi-monthly from February 2014 through August 2014.

Participants representing funded E3 projects, the U.S. EPA and the ESRC engaged in conversation about the various aspects and experiences with moving the E3 initiative forward by providing state, regional and national perspectives. #### Overview

- The ESRC is part of a network of eight pollution prevention resource exchange centers across the United States funded by the Pollution Prevention Information Network grant.
- The concept for this series is an outcome of the June 2013 E3 Virtual Roundtable (recording available online at <a href="http://esrconline.org/e3-virtual-roundtable-june-17-2013">http://esrconline.org/e3-virtual-roundtable-june-17-2013</a>). The audience was comprised of a much broader group and focus about what's happening with E3.
- The ESRC contacted E3 project leads within EPA Regions 3 and 4 to find out more about what is going on and to determine what common concerns and challenges with establishing and moving E3 forward that there might be.
- It was clear as a result of the E3 project calls that there was an opportunity for networking and to leverage the knowledge base of all of the projects across the states focused on the objectives of E3. There was interest in establishing dialog and making peer-to-peer connections to share experiences and perspectives.

- The concept for this resource emerged from the project specific calls made in the fall of 2013.
  There was a consistent affirmation across the calls that knowing about what others were doing in E3 would be a useful resource.
- A survey was sent to E3 project leads in Regions 3 and 4 to provide a means for submitting descriptive information for their E3 project.

- Each project has a web page with multi-tabbed information sections for project description, project outputs, experiences and processes utilized, partners and funding sources.
